
Interacting with Persons with Hearing Impairments

- Let the person take the lead in establishing the communication mode such as lip-reading, sign language or writing notes.
- Talk directly to the person even if an interpreter is present.



- Do not shout.
- Make sure your lips are visible.
- Rephrase sentences or substitute words rather than repeating yourself numerous times.
