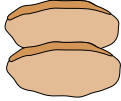


Serves 2

knife



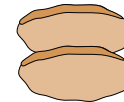
1. Preheat toaster oven to broil.



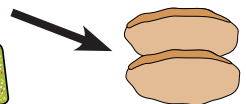
2. Cook chicken nuggets in oven for three minutes on each side.



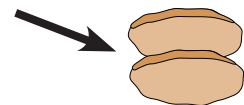
3. Cut open pita pockets.

## CARDINALS WIN

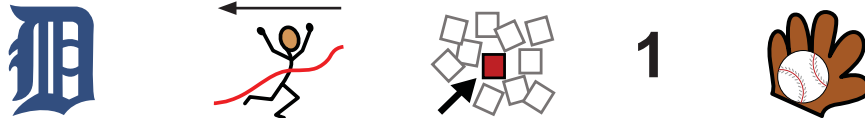
The St. Louis Cardinals won the World Series.
