Hillary Rodham Clinton is the 67th United States Secretary of State. She was a United States Senator for New York from 2001 to 2009. She was First Lady of the United States from 1993 to 2001.

Clinton attended Yale Law School graduating in 1973. She moved to Arkansas in 1974 and married Bill Clinton in 1975. She cofounded the Arkansas Advocates for Children and Families in 1977. Mrs. Clinton was named the first female partner at the Rose Law Firm in 1979 and was twice listed as one of the 100 most influential lawyers in America.
