

Assignment #3

Design a minimum of 10 multiple choice questions, including answer selections that address a topic or topics that you teach in American history.

Keep information shared by Dr. Barry and By Dr. Sarah Drake-Brown in mind when designing the questions and foils.

Be sure that the vocabulary used in the questions and answers is appropriate for the age group taught.

Before teaching the content covered by these questions, give the questions to your students as a pre-test.

After teaching the content, assign the questions as a post-test.

Example Question with 4 foils:

(You must submit 10 of these, notice the correct answer is indicated by red type.)

1. What was President Dwight D. Eisenhower best known for prior to becoming President of the U.S.?
 - A. Eisenhower was the famous scientist who developed the vaccine for polio.
 - B. He was a popular General during WWII.**

- C. Eisenhower was an action movie hero.
- D. Eisenhower was the powerful owner of a huge shipping company.
