Education Pathway Scholarship

The **Education Pathway Scholarship** is designed for individuals pursuing higher education that will lead to a teaching degree or for educators enrolled in a postgraduate Educational Leadership program.

Scholarship Overview:

- **Amount:** \$1,500
- **Eligible Districts:** Calhoun, FAMU DRS, Franklin, FSU Bay, Gadsden, Gulf, Holmes, Jackson, Jefferson, Liberty, Madison, Taylor, Wakulla, Walton, and Washington counties.
- **Awarded by:** FloridaLearns Foundation.

Eligibility Criteria:

- **For Prospective Teachers:** Accepted into a teacher education program at an accredited institution.
- **For Educators in Leadership:** Enrolled in a post-graduate program in Educational Leadership (master's, specialist, or doctorate).
- **Enrollment Status:** Must be currently enrolled and taking courses at the time of application.

Application Requirements:

1. **Essay:** A written statement detailing how the degree will improve student performance.
2. **Letters of Recommendation:** One from a current supervisor and one from a previous supervisor or another educational/community leader.
3. **Performance Appraisal:** Most recent evaluation showing satisfactory performance.
4. **Proof of Enrollment:** A current college transcript showing enrollment.

Requirements Upon Selection:

- **Headshot:** A 2×3 photo in .jpg or .png format.
- **Final Grades:** Submit final grades for the academic year the scholarship is awarded.
